

**BELGRADE BROOTEN POLICE BOARD MEETING
WEDNESDAY APRIL 19, 2023, AT 6PM AT BELGRADE CITY OFFICE**

BOARD MEMBERS PRESENT: Leah Fernelius, Brian Knight, Ray Wold. and Scott Vogel, **OTHERS:** Connie Wold.

Chairman of the Board, Leah Fernelius called the meeting to order.

The Board reviewed the Chief's report. R. Wold motioned and seconded by S. Vogel to approve hiring Bailey Wessale for the part-time officers position pending medical and psychological evaluation. Motion carried. C. Wold will check on the starting pay.

Motion by S. Vogel and seconded by B. Knight to approve the Policy and Procedures Manual Updates for Emergency vehicle operations, language changes for video retention on body and squad cameras and definitions needed. Motion carried. Board member R. Wold question the acknowledgement form and board agreed that it should be signed and L. Fernelius will check with Chief to see if this is implemented.

The current new 2022 squad will need the tires aligned after a routine maintenance check found that the rear tires are worn down and choppy. After the adjustment was made the tires will be reevaluated later.

Council member Wold gave a shout out to Chief Jansky who implemented a presentation at the high school to the 10-12 graders on the effect of Fentanyl and brought in dogs to search the students' bags/lockers. The presentation made a big impact on the students on the effect of drugs.

The board reviewed the March Financials.

The board discussed the tank in Brooten, it did not get filled when the Belgrade tank did and now has been empty for a bit. R. Wold will speak to the chief on getting fuel and also checking the fuel sheets to make sure all amounts are accounted for.

Motion by R. Wold and seconded by S. Vogel to approve the March ACH bills as presented. Motion carried.

L. Fernelius motioned and seconded by S. Vogel to approve the current April bills as presented. Motion carried.


Motion by B. Knight and seconded by S. Vogel to approve the March 9, 2023, minutes as presented. Motion carried.

The board discussed how the administrative duties between each city would be handled in the future. It would need to be discussed with each cities council before a decision can be made.
